The Maldon District Plan does not demonstrate sound infrastructure planning or delivery and therefore the plan is not considered sound.

The proposed 75 homes in North Fambridge, together with other development proposed at Burnham-on-Crouch will undoubtedly increase the traffic on the B1010, which is already well known by Maldon District Council and other local authorities / services to be a very dangerous stretch of road with a high number, and frequency, of accidents involving death and /or serious injury.

Entering the village from in an easterly direction on the B1010 is a very hazardous manoeuvre where you have to accelerate very quickly when no traffic is seen and even then you can get caught out by speeding traffic in the opposite direction. A large proportion of traffic also cuts the corner in the opposite direction which deters you from going too close to the centre of the road prior to turning. ANY villager will tell you the same story.

The proposal for development in North Fambridge seems to have been made without any objective appraisal of safety issues arising from the increased traffic entering and exiting the village. This can only make the current unsatisfactory situation even more hazardous.
