The road through Danbury is a single carriage way and incorporates a bus route, with additional traffic it has the potential of becoming grid locked. Maldon is a Market Town with a very quaint high street, bringing more people will only encourage the need for well known retailers as oppose to small bespoke outlets. The high street struggles with parking, which during the summer months is more of an issue with holiday makers etc, to have an influx of additional residents would make the problem unbearable. The car parks are already full by 10.00 AM on Saturday. The road leading up to Plume school is already very busy currently, add to that the increased traffic from the new development and progress will grind to a halt. With a substantial development such as this proposed a considerable number of new residents would need to travel by train to get into London, there is no proposal for a rail link which would therefore put strain on the road through to Hatfield Peverel station. Having recently moved to Maldon around a year ago from a very built up area on the outskirt of London Maldon offered what I was looking for, more open space and country side, and the house that we purchased on the Keeble Park estate was perfect. I do not want to be confronted by a huge housing complex right outside my front door. There must be better locations for development, particularly completely new areas around existing rail stations to the far south of Maldon. If this housing complex goes ahead it will destroy Maldon life as we know it and I suspect a lot of people will move away.
