Chelmsford City Council welcomes the opportunity to comment on Maldon District Council's Pre-Submission Draft Local Development Plan (January 2014). The Government's 'Planning Policy for Traveller Sites' (March 2012) requires authorities to identify sites to meet the full needs of Gypsies and Travellers including, a five year supply of sites. The LDP evidence base identifies a need for 64 pitches by 2019 and 70 pitches by 2027. Policy H6 (Provision for Travellers) allocates 58 pitches for Gypsies and Travellers to 2029 and proposes a set of criteria for assessing proposals for any new sites. Chelmsford City Council considers Policy H6 is not consistent with national guidance and is therefore 'unsound'. The LDP should identify additional pitch allocations to meet Maldon's needs in full, and to achieve a 5 year supply. The District is not constrained by Green Belt and the under-provision of sites increases the possibility of neighbouring authorities having to take a proportion of their unmet need. This would be unacceptable for Chelmsford City Council.
