## **Policy S2: Strategic Growth**

We are broadly comfortable with the garden suburb sites and strategic allocations shown in this policy. We note the addition of Site 2(f) since the previous consultation, although we have no comments.

We also note the addition of three reserve sites to provide further flexibility and contingency. While we appreciate that these sites will only be released for development under certain circumstances, it should be mentioned that Site RE1 (West of Maldon – Hall Farm) immediately adjoins a cluster of listed buildings to the south. There are five Grade II buildings in total, including Maldon Hall and Maldon Wycke with associated outbuildings and structures. The remains of a medieval moat enclose Maldon Hall, indicating archaeological interest. There appears to be no sustainability appraisal of the reserve sites, questioning whether RE1 in particular is suitable and justified. While it may be possible to develop Site RE1 with sufficient safeguards for the listed buildings, its identification needs to be justified and properly assessed in order to make the Local Plan sound.
