POLICY S7 - PROSPEROUS RURAL COMMUNITIES

- 1. We note that the level of growth within the Rural Areas set out in Policy S2 of the preferred strategy will, in accordance with Policy S7, be delivered in accordance with a subsequent DPD.
- 2. Whilst the principles of Policy S7 are supported, it is considered the levels of growth at Maldon and Heybridge should be reduced and development levels should be higher in the District's villages, such as Latchingdon, in order to ensure that a larger proportion of the housing supply is delivered in those settlements to help sustain sustainable rural and village communities. Whilst at present some of these settlements may have under provision of community facilities a higher level of growth could help to enable the delivery of additional community benefits and social enhancements.
- 3. In Latchingdon it is considered there are opportunities to meet the principles of Policy S7, for example to enhance settlement distinctiveness, retain key employment designations, promote sustainable transport choices, contribute to meeting affordable housing need as well as housing need for the older population.
