The Notice must be published on AT LEAST ONE OCCASION during the period of TEN WORKING DAYS starting on the day on which the application was given to the Licensing Authority (Maldon District Council).

It is for the applicant to decide in which local newspaper to publish this Notice, but the Licensing Authority believes that a reasonable interpretation of a 'local newspaper' in the relevant Regulation would include publication in the Essex Chronicle and or the Maldon and Burnham Standard. Applicants are advised to contact the Licensing Authority for clarification.
