Class II. 1

The erection or construction of gates, fences, walls, or other means of enclosure not exceeding 1 metre in height where abutting on a highway used by vehicular traffic or 2 metres in height in any other case, and the maintenance, improvement or other alteration of any gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure: so long as such improvement or alteration does not increase the height above the height appropriate for a new means of enclosure.

The use of land (other than a building or the curtilage of a building) for any purpose or purposes except as a caravan site on not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year (of which not more than 14 days in total may be devoted to use for the purpose of motor-car or motor-cycle racing or for the purpose of the holding of markets), and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that use.

The effect of the Direction, which comes into force on the date of first publication of this notice, is to require that express planning permission must be obtained before development falling within any of the foregoing classes is carried out on any part of the land to which it relates.

DIRECTION RESTRICTING PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT ON LAND
IN THE PARISH OF ALTHORNE

WHEREAS:

- 1. The District Council of Maldon (hereinafter called "the District Council") is the local planning authority under the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971, and the Local Government Act 1972, for the administrative district of Maldon, in the County of Essex.
- Article 3, of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 (hereinafter called "the Order") permits the carrying out of certain development (as specified in the First Schedule thereto) upon land to which the Order applies without the making of an application in that behalf.
- The District Council is satisfied that it is expedient in the interests of the amenities and the proper planning of the area to which this direction relates that certain development should not be carried out within the said land unless permission therefor is granted on an application duly made in that behalf.

NOW THEREFORE the District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 HEREBY DIRECTS that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order in respect of the particular development (as specified in the First Schedule hereto) shall not apply to the particular area of land described in the Second Schedule hereto.

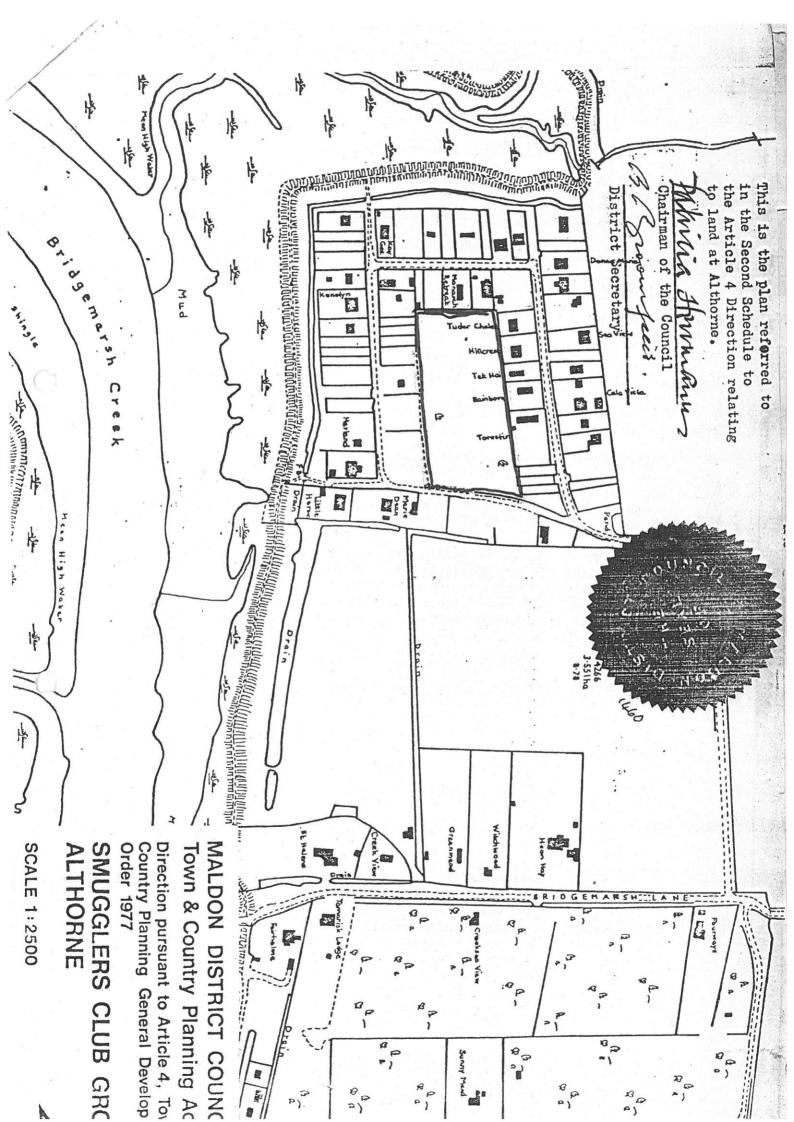
