NOTICE TO MARINERS

MALDON HARBOUR MALDON TRIATHLON

SUNDAY, 10 JULY 2022

Mariners are advised that Active Training World will be holding a Triathlon race on Sunday, 10 July 2022. High Water approximately 0946 hrs.

The racing will start off from the Public Hard on Promenade Park between the yellow slipway special mark and yellow buoy placed at 51 43.642N 0 41.826E, heading upstream in a straight line to a yellow buoy 51 43.625N 0 41.530E then turning inshore to a third yellow buoy placed at position 51 43.615N 0 41.528E to return to the start line.

A red outer limit buoy will be placed halfway along the race course and vessels should stay to the North of this buoy.

The marker buoys will be placed in position 1 hour before the start and removed on completion of the race.

River users should be aware that there may be upwards of a hundred people in the water and should stay well clear of the area.

Safety boats provided by Active Training World.

An MHIC Patrol Boat which is a dark gray RIB with an orange flashing beacon will be in attendance during the race and Harbour Users should be prepared to give way or follow directions from this Patrol Boat.

All mariners should maintain an efficient lookout, navigate with caution, and stay to the North of the channel to avoid approaching the swimmers or the intended course.

VHF Channel M1 (Ch37) will be used by the MHIC Patrol Boat
