RE: Neighbourhood Plans

'Mayland Parish Council give notice that they wish to make an application under Part 2 (5) (1) of the Neighbourhood Planning Regulations 2012 for the designation of a Neighbourhood Area for the purposes of producing a neighbourhood plan.

Mayland Parish Council is the relevant body for the purposes of section 61G of the 1990 Town and Country Planning Act to produce a neighbourhood plan, being the parish council for the area identified in the attached map.'
