

Please see below comments from South Woodham Ferrers Town Council:

Ref No

089 Paragraph 2.30 (re schools)

Secondary school requirements should be mindful of the potential impact of growth in SWF on the capacity of William de Ferrers. It is not unreasonable to assume that Plume Academy will need to take in a greater proportion of students from the southern region of Maldon District than currently.

012 Paragraph 2.71 (re highways)

Strongly encourage the development of a junction connecting the A12 and A1019 since it would help alleviate pressure on the A414 and therefore also the B1012. The B1012 does not have the capacity to be a major exit from Maldon District.

020 Paragraph 3.39 (re wind turbines)

(wrt aviation safety) Special consideration should be given to Stow Maries airfield as a site of local historical interest. Aside from visual impact on such a site the site is used by historic aircraft, any wind turbines should not hamper the function of the airfield and the historic significance should be preserved.

113 Proposals Map – North Fambridge

We were surprised to see the Settlement Boundary is being significantly expanded considering the removal of housing allocated to North Fambridge.
