RE: DRAFT LOCAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2014-2029

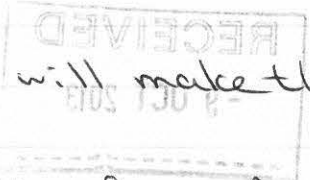
I am writing to object to the proposal above. My objections are the same as before and include: -

Schools - There are no places in Purleigh or Cold Norton. Hatchingdon is a faith school, which causes its own issues.

Transport - Having commuted on the train to London for many years, I am fed up with standing on overcrowded trains with a very limited direct route. When using my own car and trying to turn out of the village to either South Woodham Ferrers or Maldon I am delayed by the current volume of traffic and occupiers of another 75 dwellings will only exacerbate this problem.

Sewerage - My own toilets have backed up in the past as the current infrastructure is wholly inadequate for the purpose. Increasing the population of North Farnbridge will make this issue worse.

GP Services - I already wait 3-4 days to get an appointment with my doctor and increasing



The local population will make this intolerable.

Flood risk - The risk of surface water flooding would be made much worse with an additional 75 houses/dwellings.

Employment - My own family has already suffered due to the lack of employment opportunities in the village and an additional 75 dwellings will not help this situation.

I urge ^{you} to have North Farnbridge as a country village and not join it to South Woodham or Cold Norton/Latchingham.
