DOING THE WEEKLY SHOP MEANS DRIVING TO
SOUTH WOODHAM OR MALDON.
- ⑤ SCHOOLS IN THE AREA ARE ALREADY FULLY
SUBSCRIBED.
- ⑥ MUCH OF NTH. FAMBRIIDGE IS AT RISK
OF FLOODING AND THE SEWAGE SYSTEM
IS ALREADY INADEQUATE.
- ⑦ THE LOSS OF AGRICULTURAL LAND WOULD
