Having read the proposals for expansion of housing in South Maldon I would like to ask what is the SLA and compensation considerations for households such as ourselves who's current living conditions will be significantly impacted as a result of the development. I enclose as an example two views from my house showing the tranquil views experienced over the last 20 years.

The views show the location of 1700 houses which will be built over the next 15 years, so noise, visual and pollution will be a major factor in reducing our quality of life.

Road traffic problems are highlighted in the LDP but the prospect of further population with only minor changes to road networks do not bear thinking about. It took as an example 1 hour forty mins to get to Broomfield hospital yesterday in a private car as a result of traffic volume.
