**Pollution Prevention and Control Act 1999
Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010
Environmental Permit Application – Kevin Nash Group PLC**

Thank you for the submission of the eeuk LEV report for the revised extraction systems at Nash Tackle.

I note that both extraction units venting directly to air without abatement now comply with the requirements of the environmental permit in that a minimum efflux velocity of 15m/s has been achieved.

I also confirm that under the prevailing climatic conditions of the day on the 2nd November only slight odour in your car park area at the front of the building was noted when I visited. I confirm that the plant was at full production and that the laboratory was in use at this time.

Whilst you must continue to take all necessary steps to minimise offensive odour beyond the site boundary, by ensuring that you maintain good operational practices, LEV maintenance and perimeter site odour boundary checks, I confirm that Enforcement Notice reference MLD/EPR/B/008 has been lifted, and full production may once again commence.

I have also re-drafted your permit to reflect the variation application. A first draft for discussion/approval is enclosed with this letter.
