Pollution Prevention and Control Act 1999 Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 Environmental Permit Application: Maldon Fields Crematorium


Thank you for your application for an environmental permit for Maldon Fields Crematorium. I confirm that the application has been accepted as 'Granted', and a determination to that effect is enclosed with this letter. Please ensure that a copy of the permit is available for crematory staff.

The enclosed risk assessment for the remainder of the 2024/2025 inspection year (to 31st March 2024) will be 'Low Risk' on the basis that the installation is ahead of Best Available Techniques due to the installation and operation of de-NOx equipment. Risk assessments are reviewed annually, and the risk score may increase due to operational issues and/or changes in guidance.

The risk assessment score influences the annual subsistence charge paid to keep the permit valid and the frequency of compliance inspections. The pro-rata fee for the remaining months of the financial year will be £321.67 (standard fee currently £772) which will be invoiced under separate cover.
